Congregation B'nai Torah is offering a unique service as a fund-raiser for the Purim holiday. We will help you to fulfill the mitzvah of "Mishloach Manot" (the sending of two or more edible treats to your friends and family.)

For a donation of \$10 per box, you can leave the preparation and local delivery to us. Each box will contain hamantaschen, dried fruit, candy, pennies for tzedaka, and a card that lists all of the people who sent this "edible friendship note." The hamantaschen are kosher pareve. The other items are kosher dairy or pareve. We will hand-deliver the boxes to addresses in Trumbull, Monroe, Bridgeport, Easton, Fairfield, Newtown, Stratford, and Shelton. We can ship boxes to your friends, family (**collegiate children will receive a box from B'nai Torah if they are not on Spring Break**), and business associates anywhere in the U.S. for a fee of \$6.00 per box to cover the postage.
